Step 2 — Installation Warning



- All steps and procedures described in these instructions were performed while the vehicle was properly supported on a two post vehicle lift with safety jacks.
- Use caution during all disassembly and assembly steps to insure suspension components are not over extended causing damage to any vehicle components and parts included in this kit.

- ZBROZ® recommends the use of an OE Service Manual for model/year of vehicle when disassembly and assembly of factory and related components.
- Unless otherwise specified, tighten all bolts and fasteners to standard torque specifications listed within the OE Service Manual.
- Suspension components that use rubber or urethane bushings should be tightened with the vehicle at normal ride height. This will prevent premature wear or failure of the bushing and maintain ride comfort.
- Larger tire and wheel combinations may increase leverage on suspension, steering, and related components.
- Due to payload options and initial ride height variances, the amount of lift is a base figure. Final ride height dimensions may vary in accordance to original vehicle ride height. Always measure the vehicle ride height prior to beginning installation.






- Begin by making sure you are parked on a flat surface. Using a floor jack. raise the front end of your ranger and remove the front wheels and tires.
- With an 15mm end wrench and socket, disconnect the sway bar.
- IMAGE 1 Using an 8mm and a 10mm, remove the mounts holding the brake line to the upper aarm.
- IMAGE 2 Use a 15mm end wrench and socket to remove the lower shock mount bolt.
 - (i) NOTE: It is not necessary to remove the shock completely.








- IMAGE 1 Remove the two 15mm bolts holding the brake caliper, This provides clearance to remove the upper and lower ball joints.
- IMAGE 2 Using a 15mm end wrench and socket, remove the upper ball joint bolt. Gently lift on the upper a-arm and the ball joint should come out.
 - (i) NOTE: It may be necessary to remove the axle nut to slide the hub assemble from the cv shaft in order to remove the stock lower ball joint as well as installing the new ZBROZ lower arm.
- IMAGE 3 Remove the lower ball joint bolt, then maneuver the lower ball joint out of the steering knuckle.
 - (i) NOTE: You may need to remove the bolts connecting the lower a-arm to the frame before you can remove the lower ball joint.







- IMAGE 1 Before you can remove the lower a-arm bolts, you must remove the two lower bolts that hold the front bumper in place in order to rotate the bumper out of the way enough to provide enough clearance to remove the lower a-arm bolts.
- **IMAGE 2** Remove the two 15mm lower a-arm bolts holding the arm to the frame.
- Once those bolts are removed the a-arm should be free. Remove the OEM end caps and sleeves/pins. These will be used in reassembly.
- **IMAGE 3** Next, use your 15mm to remove the upper control arm, Once those bolts are removed the a-arm should be free. Remove the OEM end caps and sleeves/pins. These will be used in reassembly.



- IMAGE 1 Place the OEM Sleeve/Pin and end caps into the new ZBROZ a-arm pivot tubes the same way they were in the stock a-arm pivot tubes. Notice the caps will go with the taper towards the outside like stock.
- i NOTE: The new ZBROZ a-arms will come with bushing pre installed as well as grease zerks.



- IMAGE 1 Begin reinstalling the new ZBROZ a-arms by first placing the lower ball joint into the steering knuckle.
- **IMAGE 2** Once you have the lower ball joint in place, maneuver the lower a-arm pivot tubes into place and replace the factory nut and bolt.
- Repeat the above steps on the opposite side.
- Replace the lower bolts that hold the bumper to the frame.
- Tighten all hardware back to factory torque specifications.









- **IMAGE 1** With the lower a-arm in place go ahead and install the upper a-arm by first putting the pivot tubes into position and replacing the factory nut and bolt.
- With the pivot tubes in place, install the upper ball joint into the steering knuckle and replace the factory nut and bolt.
- **IMAGE 2** Now that the upper a-arm is in place, attach the break line to the upper arm using the factory nut and bolt that held it to the stock arm.
- After you have the break line in place, go ahead and replace the lower shock mount and torque to factory specifications.
- IMAGE 3 With the upper and lower arms in place, replace the brake caliper using the two 15mm bolts and tighten to factory torque specifications.
- Repeat all the above steps on the other side, replace wheels and tires and lower the vehicle.







- After you complete the install it is time to set your camber. Camber can differ depending on what you as a driver likes. We prefer 0 degrees to -1 degrees of camber.
- If you need less camber, remove the shim spacers until you have the desired camber.
- If you need more camber, add shim spacers to the outside of the ball joint housing as shown in the images above.
